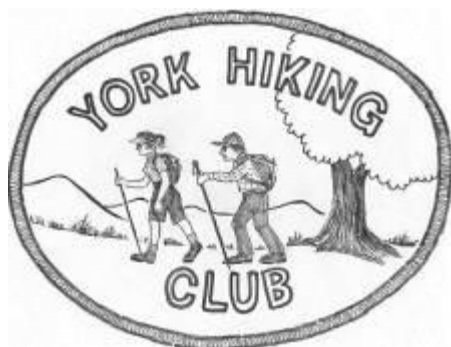

If rain occurs before hike or during the hike, the hike may not go through the underpasses. Terrain is steep in a number of areas with rocky trail.
