

Most of the hike is next to the Codorus Creek. An eagle's nest, an old caboose, the York County Astronomical Society Observatory is on route and we can see where the rail trail begins. Take your usual gear. Sunscreen is advised. There is no good place for a group to have lunch together, so -going out to a local place after is an option for anyone who wants to come.
